### 3) Review of Treasurer's Report - Barbara Ostergaard

- a) Barbara submitted the Recent Activity Report, Budget vs. Activity, Balance Sheet (year-to-date activities).
- **b)** There was a \$400 gift from Lisa Douglass and her husband who donated their Consumer's Energy volunteer hours to the Music Boosters. Kevin will send a letter to thank Douglass'.
