- · The music for *Lift Off* by Kirt Mosier has been delivered, and the Symphony Orchestra will perform it on their December concert. This was the music for the composition consortium that the orchestra joined last spring.
- The next concert is Monday, October 27. Symphony Orchestra will perform a piece alone and will also perform a combined piece with the choirs and orchestra from Dow, Midland, and CMU. The concert will be at the Center at 7:30PM.
- · The Grove Music Festival recital with Addisen Teng will be on Sunday, October 19, and all orchestra students can attend for free. The Grove Music Festival masterclass will be during 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> hour on Monday, October 20. Mia Bayardo, Sydney Ma, Kanushi Desai, and Tessa Swier will be performing.
- · All State auditions will be on October 18 and 19.
- · We're completing sign-ups and auditions for winds, brass, and percussion. There was enough interest this year that we will have to hold auditions for flute, oboe, clarinet, trumpet, and trombone.
- · Composite photos are next month on November 11 and 12.
- · Our December concert is on December 2 at 7:30PM at the Midland Center for the Arts.
